The LWVNJ Immigration Committee intends to compile several fact sheets regarding immigration issues in New Jersey. We intend these fact sheets to serve both local Leagues and the general public. As part of our work on this project, we are asking that you complete a survey in two parts.

In Part I, you will help us identify the issues that are most important in your communities.

In Part II you will help us sort out facts about YOUR communities from myths and anecdotes, or even just from general truths that fail to apply in your part of New Jersey.

You should be able to complete Part I fairly quickly by checking with other members of your League. Please complete this part by June 3 and send it back to the state office.

Many of the answers to Part II, however, will require a bit of research. We have suggested some possible resources at the top of Part II, where we ask you what resources, if any, you have used. If you need extra time to do this research, please just let us know at the end of Part I when we should expect Part II. For example some Leagues intend to work on it this summer, and others the first few weeks of the fall.

In both Parts I and II, you are free to answer “don’t know” if you simply don’t have an answer. The one exception is that we really would like your best estimate on when to expect Part II.

If you can help out by also giving us information on areas adjacent to your area, please do so.
